As you may have noticed, Kaneohe Library has been undergoing extensive construction for the few months. In order to comply with ADA regulations both our staff bathroom and our handicapped access entrance are being enlarged. What does this mean for you?

- ◆ During this period, the loss of staff parking means a shortage of public parking stalls as well. Expect parking problems during special programs and during the Friends of the Library Bookstore hours.
- ◆ There may be some excessive noise during construction times.
- ◆ While the walkway is being worked on the outside entrance stairway may be blocked off. Children, the elderly, and those who may have difficulty walking uphill on the road may need to be dropped off at the entrance.
- ◆ When the walkway is closed please be aware of pedestrian traffic on the road.
