BANNED BOOK WEEK—September 23-30

“Congress Shall Make No Law Respecting an Establishment of Religion, or Prohibiting the Free Exercise Thereof; or Abridging the Freedom of Speech, or of the Press; or the Right of the People Peaceably to Assemble, and To Petition the Government for a Redress of Grievances.”—First Amendment

During this week we celebrate intellectual freedom and our commitment to providing materials that may be unpopular or unorthodox. Support the right to express one’s opinion by reading a book that has been challenged by various libraries and schools across the nation. Some of these books deemed “inappropriate” may surprise you.

2005 Most Challenged Books

- ◆ *Forever* by Judy Blume for sexual content and offensive language;
- ◆ *The Catcher in the Rye* by J.D. Salinger for sexual content, offensive language and being unsuited to age group;
- ◆ *The Chocolate War* by Robert Cormier for sexual content and offensive language;
- ◆ *Whale Talk* by Chris Crutcher for racism and offensive language;
- ◆ Captain Underpants series by Dav Pilkey for anti-family content, being unsuited to age group and violence.

2005 Most Frequently Challenged Authors (according to ALA.org)

- Robert Cormier, author of *The Chocolate War* and *We All Fall Down*

1,607 were challenges to “sexually explicit” material (up 161 since 1999); 1,427 to material considered to use “offensive language” (up 165 since 1999); 1,256 to material considered “unsuited to age group” (up 89 since 1999); 842 to material with an “occult theme or promoting the occult or Satanism,” (up 69 since 1999); 737 to material considered to be “violent” (up 107 since 1999); 515 to material with a homosexual theme or “promoting homosexuality” (up 18 since 1999); and 419 to material “promoting a religious viewpoint” (up 22 since 1999).

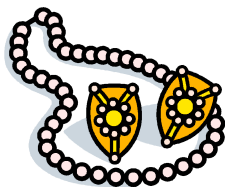

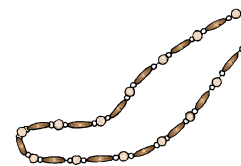
