YOU MAY HAVE NOTICED...



Construction has been going on along the driveway to the lower parking stalls at Kaneohe Public Library since early December. This is to install sewage lines to the park restrooms and the Civic Center Building. Unfortunately, this construction is contracted through February 2007. What does this mean for our patrons?

- * The driveway to the parking stalls may be limited to one lane or temporarily blocked completely. Exercise caution and be on the lookout for construction workers directing traffic and be aware of oncoming cars.
- * Four public parking stalls are being utilized by construction workers to store vehicles. This means that there are even fewer stalls available to the public. Be aware that during programs and bookstore hours parking will be extremely limited.
- * If patrons are unable to find parking stalls available in the library lot or on Waikalua Road, be prepared to either drop off passengers or simply be patient and wait for an open stall. Always have a book handy to read during these times!
- * We apologize for any inconvenience this causes to our patrons. With our library workroom next to the construction site during the hours of drilling, beeping, and pounding, we definitely sympathize with our patrons.

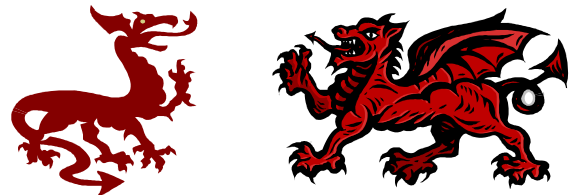
