Introduction to the Digital (PDF) Version

The study, KANEOHE: A HISTORY OF CHANGE, long out of print, has at long last been digitized. This classic book deserves widespread availability as one of the few existing histories of the fascinating Windward Oahu town on the Bay.

This is part of the continuing effort by Kaneohe Public Library to document the town's past and to provide global access. Other plans include the digitization of a Kaneohe History pamphlet, a Kaneohe History Timeline, and a Kaneohe Public Library Timeline.

The Army Corps of Engineers (Public Affairs Division), which originally contracted with Bishop Museum to do the Study, gave us permission to digitize the contents of the book. The Corps also wishes for wide access to the information as Kaneohe Bay continues to be threatened by creeping urbanization.

The original book, entitled KANEOHE, A HISTORY (1778 – 1950), was published in 1976. The 1982 Bess Press edition was used for the scanning by Advanced Micro-Image Systems Hawaii, Inc. (AMISH). Both books are available at Kaneohe Public Library
